### NOTES:

- **Changes to the Program of Learning Assessment for Nova Scotia:**
  - Nova Scotia Assessment: Reading and Writing in Grade 3 (RW3) and Mathematics/Mathématiques in Grade 4 (M4) assessments will not be administered in 2017–2018. They will be re-introduced in 2018–2019 as the Nova Scotia Assessment: Reading, Writing, and Mathematics/Mathématiques in Grade 3 (RWM3) which will be administered in spring 2019.
  - Nova Scotia Examination: Mathematics at Work10 will be discontinued starting 2017–2018.
- **Nova Scotia Examinations:** Administration dates for the Nova Scotia Examinations are fixed and set annually by the department.
- **Nova Scotia Assessments:** When scheduling assessments within the allotted period, the following requirements must be met:
  - Assessments must be completed in the mornings of the school's chosen dates; chosen administration dates do not need to be consecutive, but the assessment sections must be administered in the sequence of the booklet's order (Day 1, 2, 3, 4; for grade 6 and grade 8, Reading and Writing will be written before Mathematics).
  - Students must complete only one section ("Day") of the assessment per day.
  - Make-up days must be completed by the end of the administration period to allow for return of materials on/before the deadline.

### SCORING SESSIONS:

- Writing in Grade 6: November 5–7, 2017 (Table Leader training November 3–4)
- Writing in Grade 8: July 2018 (dates TBD)
- English 10: July 2018 (dates TBD)
- Mathematics 10 / Mathématiques 10: July 2018 (dates TBD)
